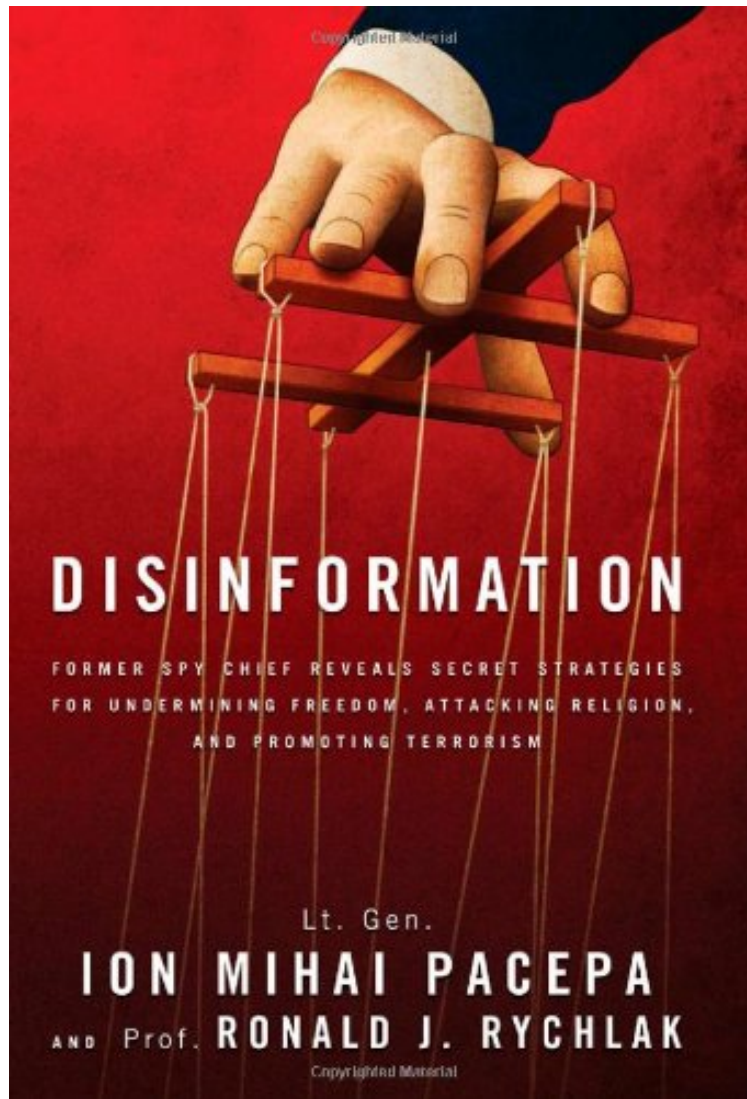

Marxism has made deep inroads into the West more than ever before today and the populace is both blind to it but given the generations of education and conditioning, they are sadly receptive to it as well from their exposure to Disinformation.
Another great book I recommend, especially as it relates to the Catholic Church and the maligned history of Christianity in general, is the newly released book Bearing False Witness: Debunking Centuries of Anti-Catholic History by Rodney Stark, who though isn't a Catholic himself, he covers some overlapping topics to Disinformation such as the false narrative Hitler's Pope and other falsities like the Spanish Inquisition and Anti-Semitism in Christianity.

The highest-ranking Soviet bloc intelligence official ever to defect to the West, Lt. Gen. Ion Mihai Pacepa is at it again.
