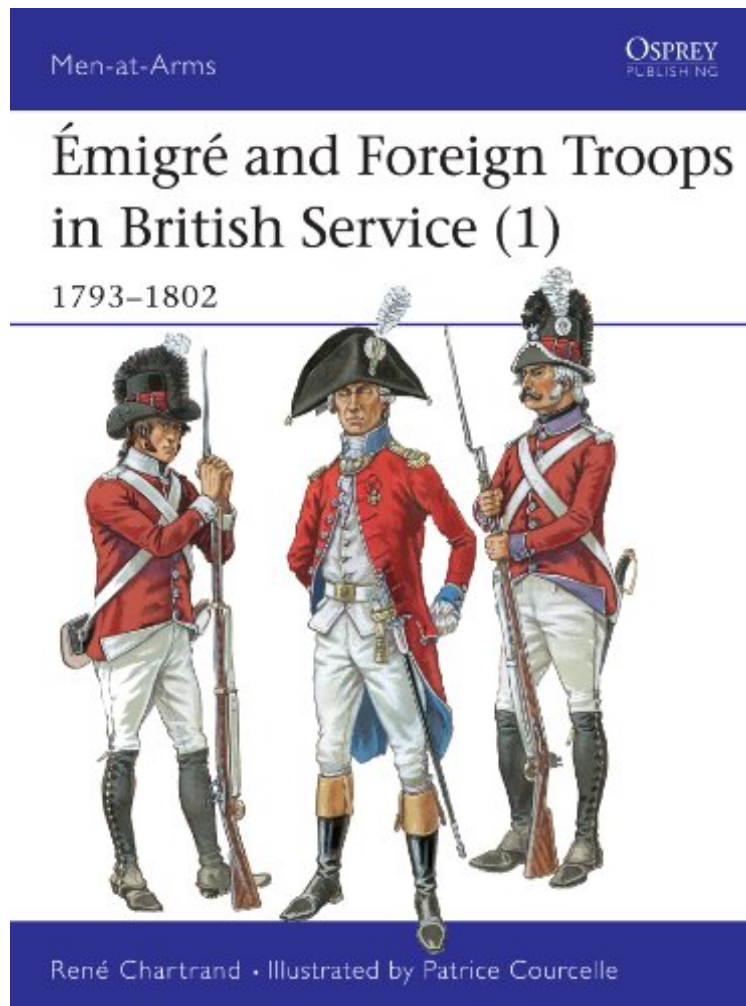

Following the Revolution in 1789, members of the aristocracy were increasingly persecuted, and many of them fled
