Tracing the rise of Europe from the 13th century through the post war era, Harper enlisted the services of some of the best historians of the era. This is history written with a heavy emphasis on the political, economic and high culture. Geoffrey Bruun's volume on the Napoleonic era is excellent and highly recommended.
