Allain This is quite entertaining reading, beyond being an account of the regiment's movements during the Civil War. I discovered it while working on genealogy and finding I have an ancestor who served in Company A of this regiment. It includes first-hand accounts from recruitment to mustering in, and training. As the chapters progress, you learn about incidents, often humorously told, of long days marching, nights huddling in a tent with rain running through it and of foraging for food to supplement the rations. There is great detail on the Siege of Vicksburg, descriptions of scenery and people... Really a great book for learning about the life of a Civil War infantryman. The copy I read was available online and was searchable.

This is a reproduction of a book published before 1923.
