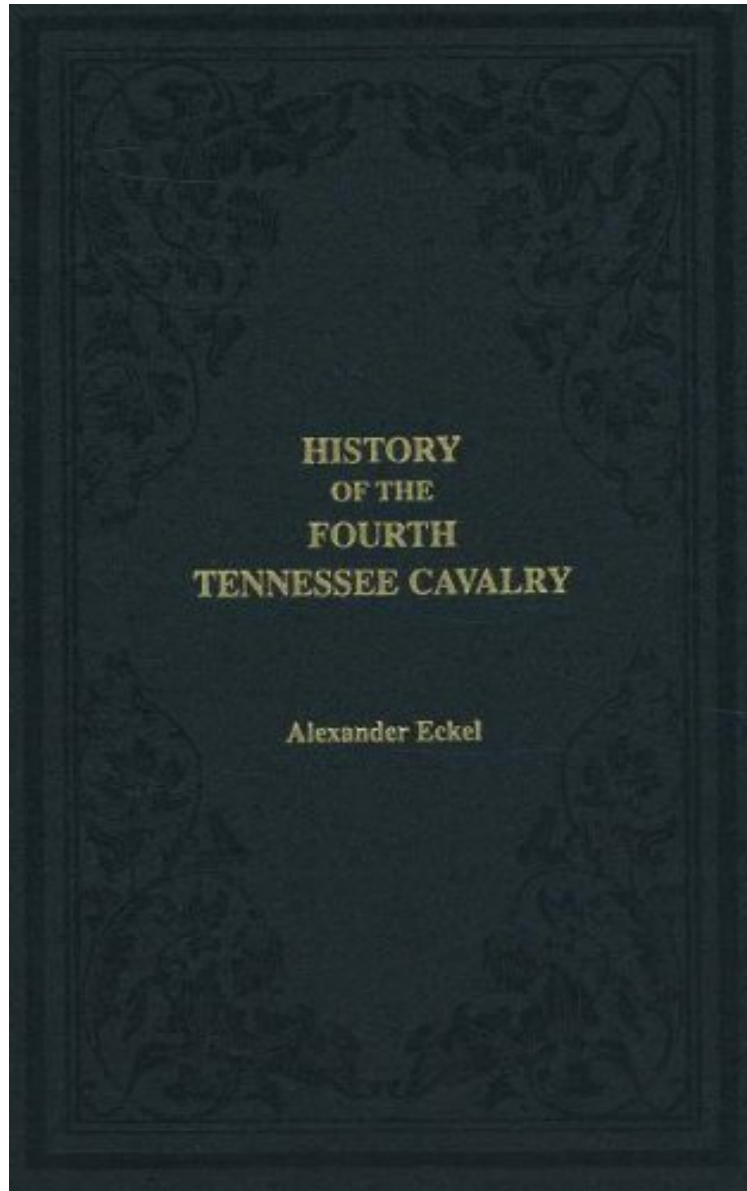

Thinking only of the bravery and mighty deeds of the Tennessee Cavalry, this volume has taken on the task of portraying the regimental history of the Fourth Tennessee Cavalry. Originally from Jefferson County Tennessee, the author served in Company C of the Fourth Tennessee Cavalry until his capture during the McCook Raid on July 31, 1864. He gives a firsthand account of the movements, battles, and issues concerning the political and military situation in East Tennessee as well as the surrounding areas.
