1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. BiasedBy TheaI got this book from the library to decide if it was worth buying and was very disappointed. There was no mention of the Scots-Irish. Even though they were originally from Scotland, they did immigrate from Ulster (after having lived in Ireland for a number of years) and populated large areas of Appalachia. This was a significant part of American history. The book also appeared to be very biased against "Protestants" and gave a narrow, one-sided view of Ireland's history with England. Perhaps that is why the Scots-Irish from Ulster were completely omitted. Any mention of Irish "Protestant" immigration is glossed over with the comment that they "were looking for a new life." No mention of how and why they ended up in Ulster or their hardships there. No mention either of their contributions in the new world. I would not buy this book.
