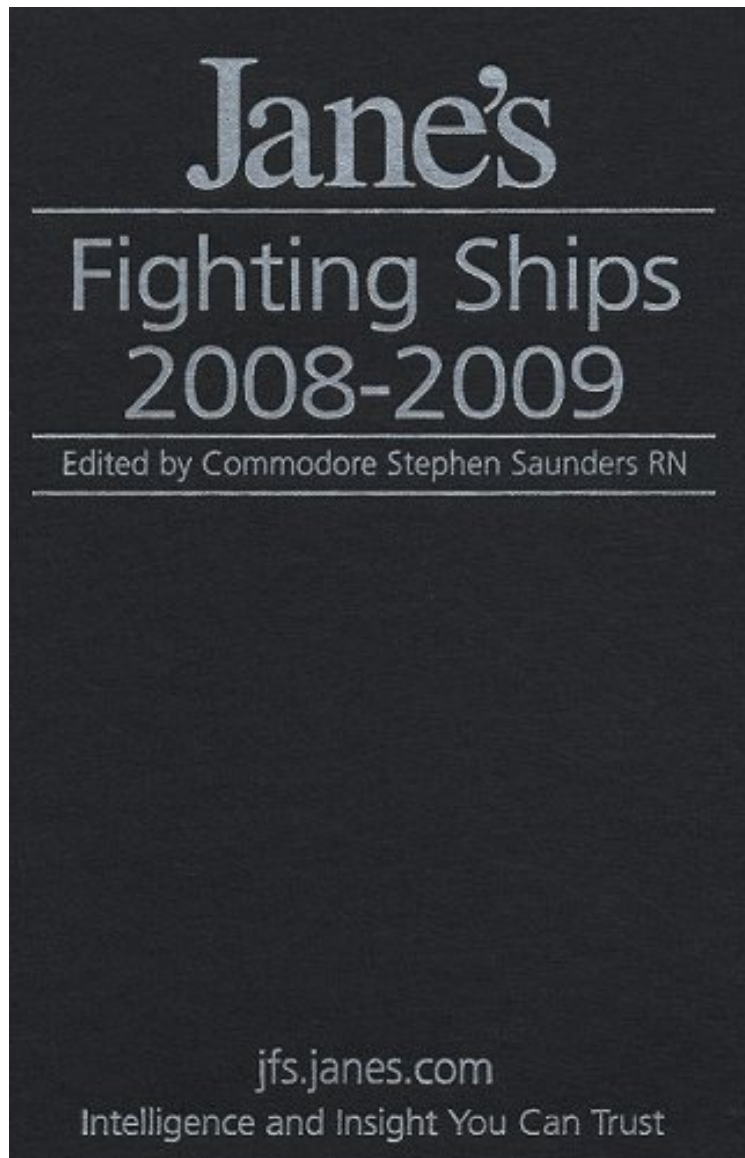

It's an exceptional resource and if you NEED a current copy you probably have one. Otherwise...Here's how to access this information for a lower cost:- Your library may subscribe- Post-cold war, there aren't that many changes each year, so copies of 3-5 years old are not totally unreasonable for the hobbyist- That same library gets rid of old copies- Older copies sometimes appear in the discount bookstores- An older copy plus the internet sometimes works for information searches- Jane's website has some of the info available for free- Also check the Naval Institute Press guides, some of them cover the same material, often cheaper
