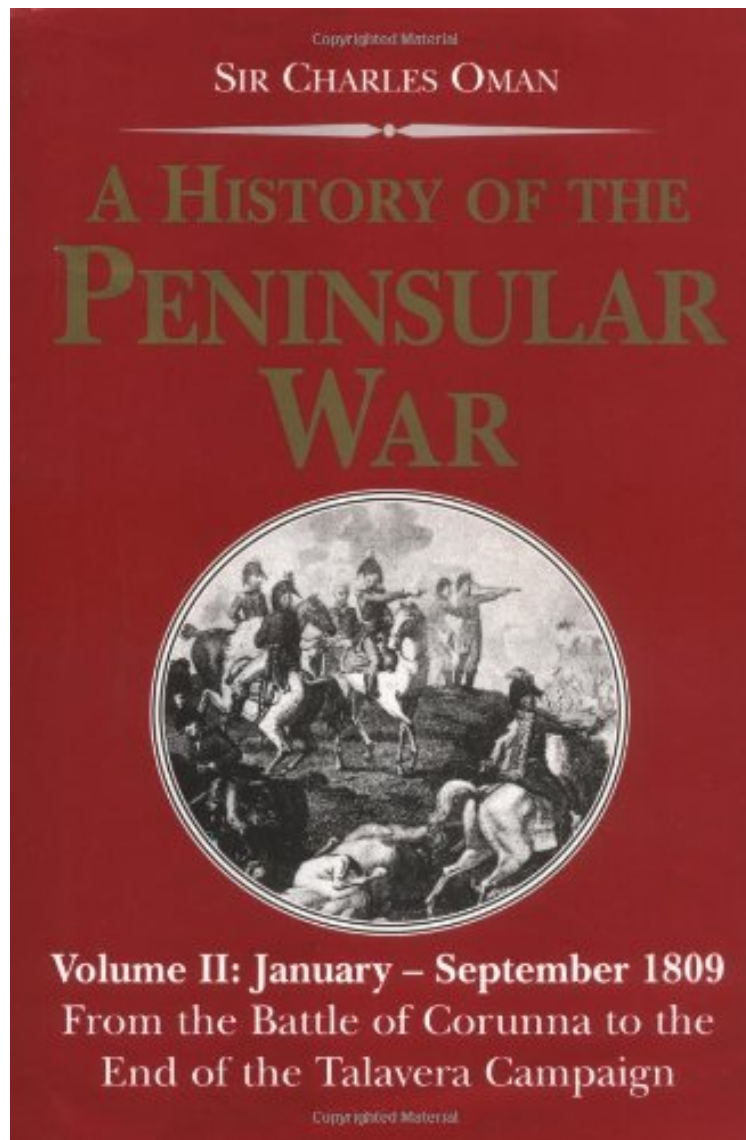


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## January to September 1809: From the Battle of Corunna to the End of the Talavera Campaign (History of the Peninsular War)

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The fate of the Iberian Peninsula was very much in the balance during the period January to September 1809, when it seemed all too possible that Napoleon would achieve control over Spain and Portugal.
