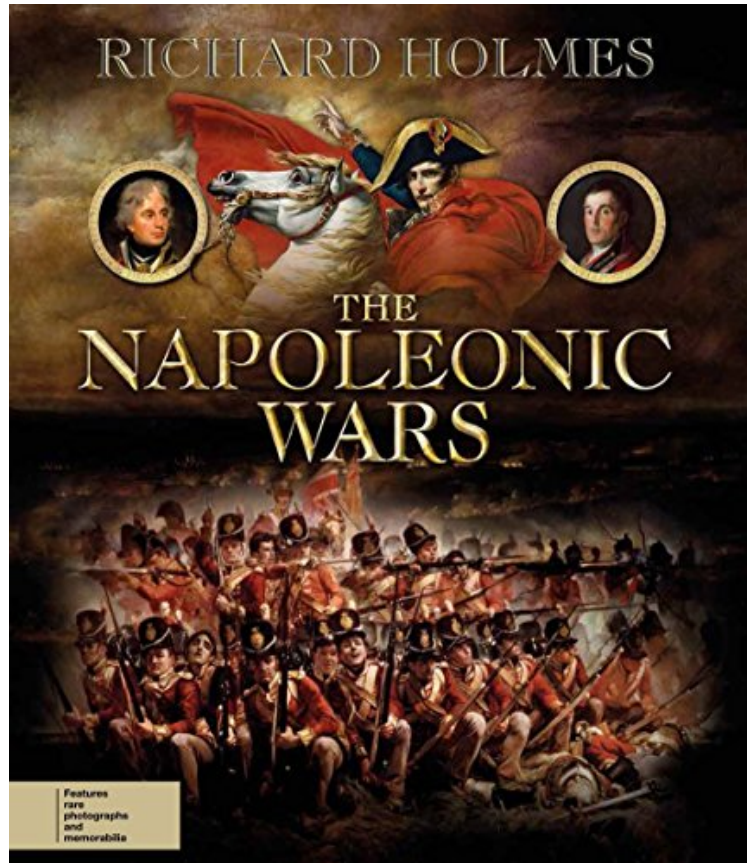

This is definitely much more in the realm of strategic level descriptions and repercussions of battles. The battles are listed, just not delved into very deeply. For someone interested in a well written summary of events this is probably ideal. If your'e looking for battlefield descriptions, tactics and maneuvers this isn't that book.
