All these old Monogram aviation publications were very well produced and written by those eminent writers Hitchcock, Merrick and Smith (4 volumes of Luftwaffe colours and a Painting Guide). But this one surely outclasses them all. The book is a binder and the pages are heavy stock which may be removed separately. They are not in colour. But there are colour chips added in the end. And perhaps this is the reason why Classic Publications attempted a newer updated version of two volumes of Merricks's Lutwaffe Camouflage and Markings which were printed thirteen years ago and were equally interesting and well received. Modern scholarship has greatly enhanced discussions about the authors past and latest appraisals of RLM colours for the benefit of modelers and others.
